Subject - Under the Maharashtra Self-Financed Schools (Establishment and Regulation) Act, 2012, approval letter has been issued to start new schools on self-financing basis or to upgrade existing schools.....

Reference - Letter of Intent No.SFS-1023 / Q.No.271 / SM-2, Date – 31/05/2023

Dhanshailya Shikshan Sansta, Akluj, Dist. Solapur has launched Dhanshailya Vidyalay, 316/2/A, Girzani, Tal- Malshiras, Dist - Solapur from the academic year 2023-24. (Primary to Higher Secondary, Class 1 to Class 12, all Branch, English Medium) Had submitted an application to start a new school on a self-financed basis.

2. Dhanshailya Shikshan Sansta, Akluj, Dist. Solapur has launched Dhanshailya Vidyalay, 316/2/A, Girzani, Tal- Malshiras, Dist - Solapur (Class 1 to Class 12, all branches, English medium) to start the construction of the school on a self-financed basis, a letter of intent was given with terms and conditions. Approval to start these new schools from the academic year 2024-25 is being given subject to the following conditions: -

3. Terms and Conditions: -

1) The proposed school shall meet all the standards, terms and conditions prescribed by the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the Maharashtra Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 and the directions issued by the Government under this Act or the standards or terms and conditions specified by the Government from time to time.

2) It is mandatory for the registered institution or trust or company to comply with all the standards, terms and conditions prescribed by the Maharashtra Self-Financed Schools (Establishment and Regulation) Act, 2012 and the

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directions given by the Government under this Act or the standards or terms and conditions specified by the Government from time to time.

3) The CBSE. Or C.I.C. or C.I.E. or I.B. It is mandatory for the school managements interested in affiliation to the board to obtain a no-objection certificate from the government as per the directions given by the government from time to time.

4) The school management shall inform the education officer of the concerned district before the beginning of the academic year approved by the government.

5) The permission granted under the provisions of this Act to establish or upgrade a new school shall be for the academic year for which it is granted.

6) If the school management fails to start the school within 18 months, the recognition letter given will be cancelled.

7) The medium of instruction approved by the school management, the location of the school cannot be changed in the future without the permission of the government.

8) If the school management has established a school in a place other than the place approved by the government, then the permission of that school will be cancelled.

9) It has been provided that the recruitment of teachers and non-teaching staff in self-financed schools should be done according to the prevailing rules and regulations of the government.

10) While filling the district-wise information, the school which has been given permission, will fill the information as "Self-financed School" as a separate category and UDISE. Will get the number. In this regard. The State Project Director, Maharashtra Primary Education Council, Mumbai has been declared as the nodal officer.

11) The school management shall put up a signboard at the entrance of the school premises saying "Self-Financed Permitted School."

12) The State Government may, at any time, cancel the recognition granted if there is a violation of any provision of this Act or the rules made thereunder, or non-compliance with any directions issued under this Act, or failure to meet the standards, norms, or terms and conditions specified by the Government from time to time.

13) It shall be mandatory to strictly implement the guidelines regarding student safety issued vide Government Circular dated 02 June, 2018 and the student safety measures as per Government Resolution dated 21 August, 2024.

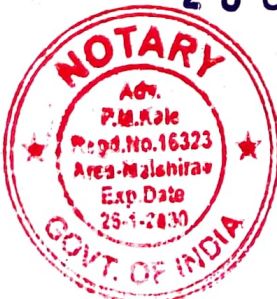
