Subject: Regarding issuing recognition certificate to schools under Section 18 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and Rule 11(4) of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011.

The Headmaster of the school had submitted a proposal to the Education Officer, Panchayat Samiti, Malshiras office for RTE recognition/renewal for the period from 01/04/2025 to 31/03/2028. After inspecting the school, the Education Officer, Panchayat Samiti, Malshiras found that the school fulfills the physical facilities as per RTE Act 2009. Based on the letter and recommendation of the Education Officer, Panchayat Samiti, Malshiras, I, the Education Officer (Primary), Z.P. Solapur, hereby grant provisional recognition/renewal to **Dhanashalya Vidyalaya, Girjani, Malshiras Tal. Malshiras, Dist. Solapur for Class 1 to Class 8** for the period 01/04/2025 to 31/03/2028 under RTE-2009.

This recognition is granted subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

1. The period of recognition will not be extended further. And after Class 8, there will be no obligation to grant recognition or affiliation to anyone under any circumstances.
2. The school shall comply with the provisions of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Schedule One) and the Maharashtra Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 (Schedule Two).
3. If the school is unaided, it shall admit children from weaker sections and disadvantaged groups in Class 1 to the extent of at least 25% of the strength of that class and provide free and compulsory education to them till completion of elementary education. The same shall also be followed for pre-primary classes.
4. For children mentioned in Paragraph 3, the school shall receive reimbursement as per Section 12(2) of the Act. For receiving such reimbursement, the school shall open a separate bank account.
5. The institution/school shall not collect any capitation fee and shall not subject the child or his/her parents/guardians to any screening procedure.
6. The school shall not deny admission to any child on grounds of lack of age proof, religion, caste or creed, place of birth, etc.
7. (1) No child admitted to the school shall be held back in any class or expelled from the school till completion of elementary education.
(2) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
(3) No child shall be required to pass any board examination till completion of elementary education.

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- (4) A certificate as prescribed under Rule 23 shall be given to every child who completes elementary education.
- (5) Students with disabilities / special needs shall be included as per the provisions of the Act.
- (6) Teachers appointed as per Section 23(1) of the Act shall possess the minimum qualifications. Teachers not having minimum qualifications shall acquire the same within 5 years.
- (7) Teachers shall perform the duties specified in Section 24(1) of the Act.
- (8) The school shall ensure that teachers do not engage in private tuition or private teaching work.
- (9) The school shall follow the syllabus based on the curriculum prescribed by the appropriate authority.
- (10) The school shall admit students without any discrimination, as per the facilities available in the school mentioned in Section 13 of the Act.
- (11) The school shall comply with the norms and standards specified in Section 19 of the Act.
- (12) The school has submitted a self-declaration to the Block Education Officer / Panchayat Samiti stating that the facilities available in the school meet all 10 requirements of RTE.
- (13) No unrecognized classes or fragmented schools shall be run in the school premises or elsewhere.
- (14) The school building or other construction and playground shall be used only for the purpose of education and skill development.
- (15) The school is being run by an institution registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (Act 21 of 1860) or the Mumbai Public Trusts Act, 1950.
- (16) The school is not being run for the profit or benefit of any individual or group of persons.
- (17) The school accounts shall be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts shall be maintained as per rules. A copy of each annual statement of accounts shall be sent to the District Education Officer (Primary) every year.
- (18) The recognition code allotted to your school is (27304100467). Please note this and mention it while corresponding with this office.
- (19) The school shall submit reports and information as and when demanded by the Director of Education / Education Officer. The school shall also comply with instructions issued by the Government or local authority for continuous fulfillment of recognition conditions or for rectifying deficiencies in the functioning of the school.
- (20) If there are any documents related to the institution's registration, ensure they are renewed.

Note: The headmaster of the school shall keep the self-declaration/documents submitted to the Block Education Officer/Administration Officer's office for RTE recognition/renewal for the year 2025 to 2028 safely with page numbers. Note that in future, applications under the Right to Information Act will be disposed of and action will be taken against the school as per rules.
